# Important Information

## Recycle your real Christmas Tree

- Volunteers will be collecting real trees on 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> January 2023 from households in exchange for a donation to Trinity Hospice. Please visit [www.fylde.gov.uk/christmas](http://www.fylde.gov.uk/christmas) to book your collection

- Alternatively, if you have a garden waste collection subscription please chop up your tree and place in your green bin ensuring the lid is fully closed

## Recycling information

- Always rinse your glass bottles/jars, cans, plastic bottles, pots, tubs and trays and foil trays, as we cannot recycle any items containing food waste
- Ensure all items are placed loose inside the green, blue and brown bins, as plastic bags can't be recycled
